GRAND KNIGHT'S MESSAGE

I would like to say it is my honor to serve this great Council of 867 of Lancaster and with you as a Brother Knight. I would like to thank all Brother Knights who have worked so hard in making the Council what it is today. It is only through your tireless efforts that we have been around for so long.

Now down to the real business at hand. We have 606 members registered at Supreme as being members of this Council. Some are not really members, almost half of the 606 Brother Knights have not paid their dues in years. This situation needs to be rectified immediately. The Council has not been very strict in collecting dues, but this has to change or this Council will not survive.

Starting July the Council will be paying to Supreme and State twice the amount of \$6.76 for each member which equals \$13.52 for the year. Your dues are \$30.00 per year, when someone does not pay the Council is still held liable for payment. When dues are not paid the paying Brothers end up paying their portion to Supreme that leaves \$2.96 left per member to take care of Council Business.

We do have Bingo every Monday Night which supports the Council and Home. We constantly ask for helpers to support this Council Activity and get no response. The people that are there every Monday Night are long time members most of which are Past Officers as well as being longtime members and are still working to keep this Council alive.

Two things need to happen: One, we need help supporting Council Activities even if it is only a couple of hours a month. We realize everybody has a busy schedules, but isn't there an hour or two that you can spare?

The act of giving is Charity which is the cornerstone of our Order, Support your Council not just with carrying a membership card but by participating. Second memberships between now and September 1, 2010 you can pay your dues, past and present with no questions asked. If you are having difficulty paying please call me @ 717-330-8448 or e-mail gk867@comcast.net and talk with me, we may be able to get sponsors to help out until you can pay on your own, or we will work something out. If you do not wish to be a Knight any longer, we regret losing you, all we need is a note telling us that you would like to leave the Council.

If we do not receive a call or letter from you by September 1, 2010, we will fill out the paperwork and send it in to Supreme asking them to suspend you. We really don't want to take this action. We prefer that you become an active paying member. The life of this Council requires that we take this action.

Also, if we don't hear from you this will be the last newsletter you will be receiving.

We intend to be around for another 100+ years, so let's keep working on keeping this Council as the largest and best in the Lancaster area.
