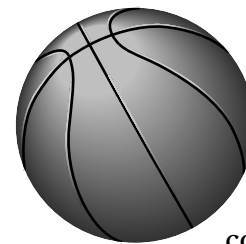
This annual youth program is open to all boys and girls, ages 10 through 14, regardless of faith or religion.
