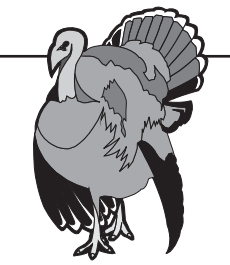

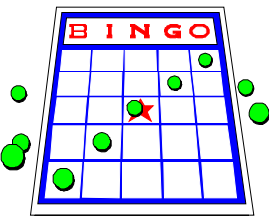

**“Change the Parking Lot” Update**


